NVHC was established in September 2012, the first developmental community handball club in North East England. We are a fully constituted amateur club, and welcome beginners and experienced handballers of all ages. We are affiliated to both the England Handball Association (EHA) and Scottish Handball Association (SHA) and have senior women's and men's teams playing in league and cup competitions. Training Sessions for Senior Players

Our senior handball training sessions take place on Monday and Wednesday evenings at our two Newcastle venues, just short walks from the city centre's St. James and Walkergate Metro stations – see our website <u>Training</u> page for venue location maps.

Please wear suitable clothing for high-impact indoor sport (t-shirt, shorts/leggings and trainers), no jewellery, tie long hair back, and bring a water bottle and your own handball.

Home matches take place at the Benfield Sports Centre in Newcastle or at Scottish centralised venues. As well as playing in friendly matches and tournaments, including our own annual Tyneside Handball Tournament, we also often compete in the British Beach Handball Championships. Outdoors summer training focuses on fun sessions of beach handball or in the park.

All membership fees go towards the club's running costs, hall hire and handball equipment, as well as to cover some of the match day costs. We will also cover the costs of EHA/SHA coaching and refereeing courses, DBS, child safeguarding and first aid qualifications if you remain with the club for at least another year.





^{*} Casual membership (non-regular attendance) – a pro-rata amount of the £300 half-season fee will be agreed with our club Treasurer.

^{*} Students also paying a university/college handball club membership – a further discounted rate will be agreed with our club Treasurer.

Pro-rata membership refunds will be based on a 10-month season September-June, and only apply if handball is cancelled on health and safety grounds for 1 month or more by EHA/SHA or lockdowns imposed by national Government or local authorities.



All players, coaches and volunteers MUST also individually register themselves with the EHA for public liability and personal injury insurance purposes, and to be able to take part in leagues and other competitions. £12.50 fee for adults, £7.50 for under-19s.
